



Thorpe Meadows is the main home to our collection with 17 sculptures displayed in a parkland setting along the south side of the Peterborough Rowing Course. The hotel and pub at the head of the rowing course both provide meals and drinks in attractive settings overlooking the water. A walk through the sculpture park would take no more than half an hour. Stout shoes are recommended after wet weather.

Getting to Thorpe Meadows:

The Meadows are approximately one mile from the City Centre railway and bus stations.

By Car:

Follow the A1179 out of the City Centre heading west and then turn left into the hotel/pub car parks. From the A1 enter Peterborough on the A47 or A1139 turning right or left respectively onto the A1260 and then turning onto the A1179 as shown on the map.

By Bus:

There is a bus service from the city centre bus station.

On Bicycle:

The Meadows are accessible by cycle. A Peterborough Cycle Map showing all city cycle routes and other information on cycling in the city is available from the Tourist Information Centre tel. 01733 452 336
