

Can't come to us? We can come to you! Peterborough Museum Outreach **Toys from the past** KS1 Session



Peterborough Museum has a large selection of toys dating back from Victorian times to the 1970s which we can bring out to your school - perfect for topics looking at playtime, childhood and materials. This session is adaptable for KS2 looking at the theme of play and leisure time.

Duration:	40 mins – 1 hour depending on number of classes.	
What happens:	A range of toys from the past are looked at focusing on its type, the material it's made from, how it works and how it compares with toys within living memory. Then pupils explore further with real and replica toys and games through enquiry-based play and discussion.	
Maximum group size:	Up to 35 pupils. We can work with one group at a time and up to five groups in a full day (from 9:45am)
