 Peterborough Museum Outreach
Fossils & Evolution upper KS2 Session



In the Age of the Dinosaurs, 150 million years ago, this area was under a shallow tropical sea, teeming with life. Peterborough Museum has a superb, internationally important collection of fossils from the Jurassic period, all found locally. Let us bring some of this collection out to your school as pupils discover what fossils tell us about living things that inhabited the Earth millions of years ago and how they provide evidence of adaptation and evolution.

Duration:	Approx. 45 mins.						
What happens:	Children work in groups as they handle the fossilised remains of the plesiosaur, ammonite, ichthyosaur and belemnite. The discussions initiated are supported with a power point and therefore access to a laptop and whiteboard are required.						
Maximum group size:	Up to 35 pupils. We work with one group at a time and up to five groups in a full day (from 9:30am)						
Recommended ratio:	Minimum 1 adult to 10 students.
