

Can't come to us? We can come to you! Peterborough Museum Outreach **Story of Peterborough** KS2 Session



Peterborough Museum's collection spans over 150 million years of local history. We can bring a selection of this range to your school for a hands-on, object and enquiry based activity. It is perfect for local history and for developing chronological understanding and analytical skills.

Duration:	40 mins – 1 hour depending on number of classes.	
What happens:	Pupils are informed that we are here because we have been told that they are great history detectives! Unlabelled mystery objects have been delivered to the museum and we need their help in identifying what they are and what they tell us about Peterborough and how it's changed over time. Pupils will create object timelines and then these are used to tell the story of Peterborough. A power point supports the story and objects and so access to a laptop and whiteboard are required.	
Maximum group size:	Up to 35 pupils. We can work with one group at a time and up to five groups in a full day (from 9:45am)
