Tudor Peterborough (Living History) KS1&2 Session



This was a period of great change for Peterborough and unfortunately also the time of some very nasty diseases and even nastier cures. Time-travel back to 1574, dress up in replica Tudor clothing of local Tudor characters and receive a Tudor aliment!

Duration:	Approx. 45 mins.
What happens:	We first look at images of maps of Tudor Peterborough and portraits from our collection of some local significant characters. Pupils are dressed up in replica clothing of these and other characters. What do the portraits and clothing tell us about the sitter and about this period in history? With our Tudor surgeon, pupils will find out about the illnesses of the time and how the changes brought about in the Tudor period altered the way patients were treated and how, gradually, old ideas were challenged. In KS2, pupils are asked to consider the responses and impact of the new ideas at this time. Each class will make a pomander to keep in school.
Maximum group size:	Up to 35 pupils. We can work with one group at a time and up to four groups in a full day (from 9:45am)
