Human Evolution upper KS2 – KS4 Session



This hands-on workshop challenges pupils to explore the evolutionary relationships between present day and ancient humans, collectively known as hominins.

Duration:	Approx. 45 mins.
What happens:	Working in 3 groups with an adult, students will be guided through some of the techniques employed by scientists studying human evolution. For example; observation-based comparative anatomy and, if appropriate, quantitative comparison using cranial measurements. The discussions initiated are supported with a power point and therefore access to a laptop and whiteboard are required.
Maximum group size:	Up to 35 pupils. We work with one group at a time and up to four groups in a full day (from 9:45am)
Recommended ratio:	Minimum 1 adult to 10 students.
